

GENERAL INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

Artists 18 years or older may enter two 2-D works and/or two 3-D works of pottery or sculpture. Work must be original, entirely the work of a single artist, executed within the last 3 years, and not exhibited in any previous Summer Regional Show. No computer-generated or digitally altered imagery, photography, air brush, furniture, fiber art, or tole painted pieces will be accepted. AAS reserves the right to refuse any work that is not properly presented, requires special installation, or is deemed inappropriate by the AAS Media Committee.

All work must be for sale. AAS will retain a commission of 25% for members and 35% for non-members on all sales. The artist is committed to the sale price on the entry form. Entries must remain for the duration of the show (unless sold). This is a juried show. Work not selected for the exhibit may be picked up during gallery hours throughout the month.

PRESENTATION SPECIFICATIONS

- All 2-D artwork must be framed, wired, and ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers.
- Gallery wrapped canvas must be at least 1.25" deep and all edges must be painted.
- Rigid plexiglass is required for pieces over 30" in any direction.
- Maximum framed size cannot exceed 50" in any direction.
- Minimum framed size must exceed 12" in any direction.
- No artwork may exceed 50 lbs.
- Work needing special installation will not be accepted.

LIABILITY

Work is entered at the risk of the artist. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the work, neither AAS nor its representatives will be responsible for damage or loss from any cause. Submitting a work of art shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist to the conditions set forth in this prospectus.

JUDGES

Carrie Burns Brown 2-D Judge

Carrie Burns Brown, NWS, from Greenville, SC, is an experimental watermedia artist and national juror. She is also a noted instructor, having amassed 40 years of teaching experience throughout the United States and Canada. A native of Georgia, Carrie studied art at Mercer University and the Art Institute of Atlanta. She continued her art education at Furman University in Greenville, SC. She has been an instructor at the Greenville Museum Center for Education since 1977. She is also a returning instructor of the Springmaid Watermedia Workshops where she has taught since 1985. In addition to a productive career as an artist and art educator, she has served on the board of the South Carolina Arts Commission.

Cynthia Bringle 3-D Judge

Cynthia Bringle is a ceramic artist, who lives and works in Penland, NC. She earned a BFA from Memphis Academy of Arts and a MFA from Alfred University, NY. Cynthia is a NC Living Treasure-University of North Carolina Wilmington, a life member in the Southern Highland Craft Guild, a fellow of the American Craft Council, and the recipient of the North Carolina Award for Fine Art. She received an Honorary Doctor of Fine Arts from Memphis College of Art. Her work is included in private collections, the Mint Museum of Craft and Design, Burlington Art Centre, and the High Museum of Art, but mostly it is found in many kitchen cabinets.
