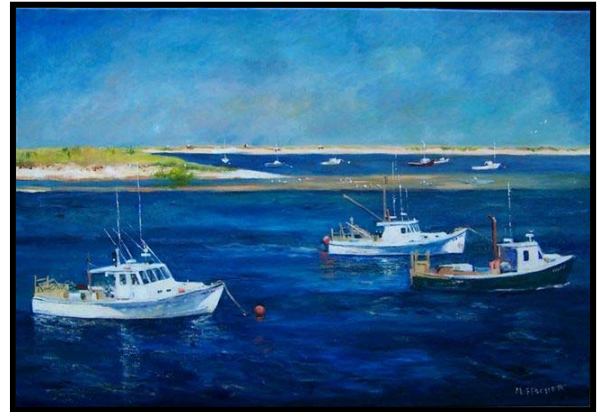

AAS MINI 3D WORKSHOP

Clay Techniques:

Carving / Piercing / Making Handles

Instructor: Tonda Jeffcoat

September 17, 2011

In this daylong workshop, you will learn Tonda's techniques of carving, piercing, and adding handles to the pieces you make. The first half of the day will be devoted to using various carving and cutting tools to create free-form and pattern surface designs on leather-hard pieces.

Participants will also learn to use an exacto knife for piercing to create lanterns, candle cups, and the edges of plates and platters.

The second half of the day will focus on making a variety of handle styles: rolled, using a handle maker, and more. By the end of the day, you'll learn the dreaded "pulled" handle does not have to be "scary."

OUTSIDE POTTERY WORKSHOPS BY NAN ROTHWELL in Nelson County, Virginia.

July 8-10, 2011 Altering Thrown Forms

A three-day hands-on workshop. Starting with round wheel-thrown components, we'll work on squared and oval shapes, and on ways to texture and alter thrown pots while they are still on the wheel. During this three-day workshop, we'll make and finish several projects which students may take home leather-hard. The workshop fee of \$300 includes clay and lunch both days. Enrollment limited to eight students.

August 6-7, 2011 All About Lamps

A hands-on workshop on making and wiring lamps. Because one can predict how they'll be lit and the angle at which they are likely to be seen, lamps offer a great chance to play with texture and other design elements. During this two-day workshop, we'll make and finish wheel thrown lamp bases and have a quick lesson on wiring them and choosing harps and shades. The workshop fee of \$200 includes clay, lamp hardware for two lamps, and lunch both days. Enrollment limited to eight students.

There are a number of B&B's quite near here and when people inquire about workshops, I send them links and descriptions to them. There is also a large resort nearby called Wintergreen. (Sometimes when spouses accompany people to the area, they choose to stay at Wintergreen, to have access to skiing or golf.) Clyde Connell: Swamp Songs

Brown Wing

In a New York Times obituary, noted art critic Roberta Smith described Louisiana artist Clyde Connell's source of inspiration: "Like O'Keeffe, she drew inspiration from the region in which she lived. She used brown earth and red

clay to color her drawings and sculptures, as well as bits of iron scrap that her son, Bryan, a cotton farmer, found in his fields. She had a mystical view of nature and described her drawings as transcriptions of its music, heard on the bayou."

This exhibition, organized by the Cameron Art Museum, includes work loaned from the collections of Connell's family members and other private collectors, in addition to work from The Ogden Museum of Southern Art, New Orleans, LA and the National Museum of Women in the Arts, Washington, D.C.
