## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Please read carefully.**

### **Eligibility**

Any artist 18 years or older may enter two works, any combination of 2D or 3D (pottery or sculpture). Work must be original, entirely the work of a single artist, executed within the last 3 years, and not exhibited in any previous AAS Summer Show. No computer-generated or digitally altered imagery, no photography, air brush, furniture, quilting, quilling, stained glass, floral arrangements, jewelry, or tole painted pieces will be accepted. The gallery cannot hang glass pieces, however, freestanding entries in glass are acceptable if they are in the 3D category. AAS reserves the right to refuse any work that is not properly presented, requires special installation, or is deemed inappropriate by the AAS Media Committee.

All work must be for sale. On all sales AAS will retain a commission of 25% for members and 35% for nonmembers. The artist is committed to the sale price on the entry form. Entries must remain for the duration of the show (unless sold).

### **Artwork Specifications**

- All 2D artwork must be framed, wired, and ready to hang.
- 2D artwork may not exceed 15 pounds.
- No saw-tooth hangers are permitted.
- Gallery wrapped canvas must be at least 1.25" deep and all edges must be painted.
- Rigid Plexiglas is required for paintings over 30" in any direction.
- Maximum framed size cannot exceed 50".
- 3D artwork may not exceed 50 lbs.
- Work needing special installation will not be accepted.

## **LIABILITY**

Work is entered at the risk of the artist. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the work, neither AAS nor its representatives will be responsible for damage or loss from any cause. Submitting a work of art shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist to the conditions set forth in this prospectus. I understand that AAS may photograph any art in the gallery for publicity purposes.

### SHOW JUDGES

#### Sidney Godwin, 2D Judge

Sidney K. Godwin is a former professor of art and Director of the Center for the Visual Arts in Lincroft, New Jersey. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Virginia Commonwealth University and a Master of Art from Rutgers University. Since retiring he lives in Southport, North Carolina and devotes his time to his painting.

Mr. Godwin has exhibited professionally since 1970. His artwork is in corporate, institutional, and private collections both nationally and in Europe. His artwork can be found in the Pfizer Corporation art collection, Bank of Virginia, The Mariners Museum, Newport News, Virginia, Rutgers University, and Virginia Commonwealth University.

#### Adrian Spencer Hayden 3D Judge

Adrian Spencer Hayden is a multi-media artist and instructor: Native Virginian, Hayden has over 100 first place and "Best in shows" awards to his credit in five different media. His artwork can be found in galleries, museums and private collections throughout North America, South America, Europe, Japan, and Korea. He is currently exhibiting his artwork in a few select art galleries. He says, "My education in art is extensive. I will look for the well-executed and confidence with the medium and subject. Innovation is a must! Hayden currently resides in Southport, NC with his wife, where he teaches Intermediate Pottery, Advanced Clay, as well as advanced silver smithing, beginning and intermediate "Art Welding and metal sculpture" and, when needed, beginning and advanced wood turning. He is currently creating a new Metal Art program at Brunswick Community College, North Carolina.
